Pompey Pool League – Registration Summer 2018.

Thank you to all Teams who have played pool in the Winter League. We welcome your registration for the Summer League 2018.

The timetable for the Summer League is as follows:

30th March – Summer League Sign-On Packs to be distributed to all Portsmouth Pool Venues and available on-the web site.

23rd April – Registration Night at The Newcome Arms starting at 7:30pm. This is the cut-off date for Summer League Registration. Entries will only be accepted at the Newcome Arms.

16th May – Fixtures available (Distributed to the venues and on the web site).

23rd May – First Match of Summer League.

Entry fees are £30 per Team, Singles £2 per person and Doubles £4 per Team. Please make all cheques payable to “Pompey Pool League”.

The format for the Summer League will be as played for the two last years, with a randomly drawn Leagues, followed by knockout competitions based on the final placings in each League.

Single and Doubles competition will be double banked where possible (2 rounds to be played on one night), so that Single and Doubles competitions do not have to be played every Monday.

Any venues that have outstanding fines and who wish to enter into the Summer League must pay their outstanding fines in addition to their entry fees before they will be accepted into the Summer League.

Please note that we will be trailing some rule changes for the Summer League pending a vote by the Members at the AGM to decide if these changes should be permanently adopted. These changes are:

1. Removal of nomination of colour off the break.

Rule 4e becomes “If no ball is pocketed from a legal break, then play continues with an open table until such time a ball is legally pocketed. Once a player legally pockets an object ball, then that denotes his/her group.”

2. Remove the toss of the coin, introduce alternate refereeing and alternate breaks.

Rule 4b becomes: Referee Order and Break.

3. Increase the penalty if an opponent's ball is pocketed as a result of a foul shot. In this case the following 2 shot penalty WILL carry.

For this rules 6d and 6e are added:

6d " Two shots will carry to the end of his/her visit." And

6e "If a player pots (accidentally or intentionally) any of an opponent's object balls, the penalty will be 6a-6b and 6d will replace 6c."

These and all other changes to the rules of play will be voted by the members at the AGM to be held at the end of the Summer League.
