5. League Format

With 32 teams and after much debate, it was decided to revise the format to have 4 Leagues of 8 teams rather than 3 Leagues of 12. The 3 League format would have needed to include 4 byes and would have meant many gaps in the playing calendar, especially for Division 3.

It was decided that the format will be a 4 League format where each team plays three times. It was understood that this will give some teams a slight home advantage on the third leg but this was outweighed by the fact that play will be continuous through the season and provides the correct length for the Winter League.

It was reaffirmed that all Cup/Shield games will be played on Wednesdays.

This format leads to a finals night of 9th May 2015.

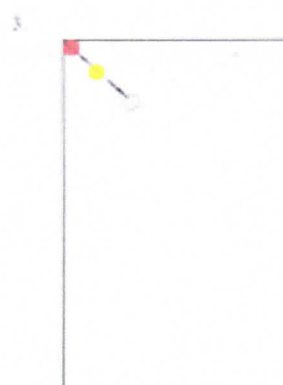
Where the game is lost after committing a deliberate foul could your committee please give some clear statements as to what constitutes a deliberate foul? When assessing the below examples.

1. The player does not attempt to hit his own object ball with the cue ball but deliberately plays his opponents ball or the black ball with or without using the cue ball.



When attempting to play the last black ball, but is snookered by the opponents red ball?

- a) The player playing the black ball deliberately plays short?
- b) And if deliberately playing short is a deliberate foul how far short if allowed, what is a reasonable attempt?



When attempting to play your yellow onto your opponents red ball?

- a) The player, playing the yellow ball deliberately pots his opponents red ball and his yellow follows in and is potted?
- b) What happens after playing the same shot his yellow does not pot?



if above 3b is a deliberately foul

- a) What happens when the player, playing his yellow into the right side pocket deliberately sends the cue ball into his opponents red ball and then pots both?
- b) What happens in the same shot but he misses the yellow pot but still pots the red?
