### 1. Summer League Format Options

The following format options were proposed by the Committee:

- a. Re seed teams for summer, then play as winter league, cup, trophies, etc.
- b. Draw teams out then play as winter league, cup, trophies, etc.
- c. Teams either seeded or drawn into Divisions. Just a trophy for pub winners, runners up, no individual trophies

Play the Season then run into a Knockout competition. Top half of each Division in 1<sup>st</sup> knockout competition and bottom half of each division into 2nd knockout competition. Trophies for knockout winners, runners up and 1 returnable for the pub and 1 to keep for individuals.

No cup in the Summer. Singles/Doubles on Mondays.

- d. Teams either seeded or drawn into Divisions. Play the first half of Season. After 1<sup>st</sup> half of season, re-mix the Divisions. Top half of Division 1 and Top half of Division 2 become new Division 1. Bottom halves of Division 1 and 2 become new Division 2 and so on through the Divisions. New fixtures for 2<sup>nd</sup> half of League published and played. All teams would retain their results and points with new fixtures for second half of season,

Note: requires an even number of Divisions.

Cup on Wednesday, Singles /Doubles on Monday.

These options were presented by the committee.

Two Votes were taken:

**Do you wish the Summer League to be Seeded or Drawn Randomly?**

Unanimous Vote for League to be drawn randomly.

This vote ruled out Option A

**Which format option do you want?**

Option B – 2 Votes

Option C – 21 Votes

Option D – 4 Votes

As a result it was decided that the format to be used for the Summer League will be option C above with a random draw.

2. **Doubles format:** Play Scottish Doubles (Players alternate each shot rather than alternating each visit).

**The vote was taken for or against:**

For - 22

Against – 4

Abstain – 1

As a result, the Scottish Doubles format will be adopted for the Summer League.

3. **Breaking:** Remove toss of coin and break alternately.

**The vote was taken for or against:**

Against – Unanimous

As a result the toss of a coin to decide the Team that breaks, will remain.

4. **Refereeing:** in a fixed alternate format rather than the current rule that the away Team referees all games.

**The vote was taken for or against:**

Against – Unanimous

As a result the current rule that the away Team referees all games, will remain.
