Minutes from Open Meeting 9th May at The Mermaid.

The items discussed at the summer sign on night were:

- Doubles Format.

It was decided that the Scottish format of doubles would be retained going forward.

It was decided that talking between shots in the doubles (other than choosing colour of balls to be played) would no longer be allowed. The only talking that will be allowed is before a Team starts their visit to the table. This is intended to reduce the length of doubles matches.

- Singles, Doubles – Match lengths.

It was agreed that the Singles and Doubles match lengths would be 5 games for all preliminary matches, 7 games for semi-finals and 9 games for finals.

As a result the Scottish Doubles rules have been updated (and are available on the web site) and Rule 9f has been updated to read “The format for singles and doubles competitions will be the best of 5 games for all preliminary matches, 7 games for the Semi-Finals and 9 games for the Finals.”.
