



Trial rule for Summer 2023 - Teams fielding less than 6 players.

Purpose.

To allow teams who can only turn out with 5 players or less, to play as many matches as possible.

<u>Rules.</u>

Under these circumstances, the team(s) with less than 6 players will be allowed to play one player twice in the singles and one player twice in the doubles.

With 5 players:

- For the Singles, once the team has been written down, the opposing Team makes a random draw from 1-5 to select who plays the 6th Singles.
- For the Doubles, once the team has been written down, the opposing Team makes a random draw from 1-4 to select who also plays in the 3rd Doubles.

With 4 players:

- For the Singles, once the team has been written down, the opposing Team makes a random draw from 1-4 to select who plays the 5th Singles.
- For the Doubles, no redraw makes up a 3rd doubles match, so this does not apply.

The same pattern continues for 3 or less.

The results of a redrawn singles match will not count towards the singles aggregate competition.
